Governor's Proposal: highlights

- Proposing a new strategy for Foundation Aid by consolidating aid categories.
- Building Aid. Proposing a new tier for projects approved after July 2020. Restrictions on field construction.
- Transportation Aid. Reduces it.
- Vaping. Prohibition on flavored e-cigarettes.
- STAR. Reduces eligibility from \$250K to \$200K.

Mini-capital Projects

Facilities Planning has a special provision for what they call mini-capital projects.

Project <\$100,001 for Capital Outlay Exception Aid

This item is used to record 2018-19 expenditures paid from current resources for a SOLELY BUDGETARY project with a total cost of no more than \$100,000. A district may receive aid for a maximum of one such project in any school year. The district must contact Facilities Planning, in writing, for a determination of project eligibility. Please note that only projects approved by the Office of Facilities Planning specifically for this category will be eligible to receive state aid.

Propose that we keep a line in our general budget on a recurring basis as we have been doing. There is a bill in the Legislature once more to raise to \$250,000.
